

Through hands-on investigations and inquiry based science learning opportunities, Dunbar Elementary Magnet School provides a rigorous program of study which is driven by a culture of high expectations and student ownership. We encourage our students to positively impact the world through our character education program and an emphasis on medical and science integration.

Dunbar's mission is to integrate medical sciences using meaningful explorations within all content areas. Students have an ongoing opportunity to engage in real-world learning situations within the medical and scientific community not only though enhanced curriculum instruction, but also through our partnerships with The B.ES.T. Academy, Rassmussen College of Nursing, Tampa General Hospital, USF Health, University of Tampa School of Nursing, More Health, Inc., The Leukemia and Lymphoma Socity, and more!

Every Dunbar Medical Student is assigned to one of four houses upon enrollment: House of Neurology, House of Physiology, House of Zoology, and House of Botany. Together with their housemates, students learn how to keep a PULSE on their learning by: Participating in their learning, Uniting in their community, Listening attentively, Showing kindness, and Empowering themselves and others. Students in each house also work together to complete a service learning project to give back to our West Tampa community. These student-led projects, under the supervision of our
