South Tampa Academy @ Monroe Middle Magnet Uniform Policy 2022-2023



South Tampa Academy @ Monroe Middle Magnet believes that our uniform policy promotes a positive learning environment and contributes to school pride, spirit and safety. The student uniform shall consist of the following:



Tops

Solid Polo Shirt (School "Spirit Shirts" can be worn on Friday)

Colors- White, Black, Red, and Grey

Hoodies/Jackets

- School Logo Hoodies (Purchase from PTSA \$30.00)
- College Logo Hoodies
- Wearing an oversized outer garment or long-sleeved shirt over the school uniform is not acceptable unless the garment has the school logo on it.

Bottoms

Shorts, skirts, skorts, capris, and jumpers may be worn. Short skirts, miniskirts, yoga style stretch pants/leggings, sweatpants or corduroy pants are not acceptable. Pants should not have holes. Hemlines shall be no shorter than fingertip length. All "bottoms" must be worn fastened at the waistline, solid color, and without logos or prints of any kind. (Jeans, without holes, may be worn with school "Spirit Shirts" on Friday)

Colors- Khaki/beige, Black, and Grey

Shoes (District guidelines for Safety)

- Closed toed shoes only
- <u>No</u> slides/Slippers/Skate Tennis Shoes
- Crocs must be worn with the strap on the ankle. (When the strap is not worn on the heel it becomes a slide which does not meet the district guidelines.)

Other Guidelines

- Students <u>may not</u> wear garments and/or jewelry that may provoke violence and/or a disruption.
- Students may NOT wear hats, hoodies, or any other distracting items while on campus.
