All Carrollwood students are expected to wear their uniforms everyday to school. If a child is out of uniform, the parent may be called to bring the appropriate clothing. If we are unable to contact a parent, a uniform will be provided to the child for the day from our clothes closet.

Carrollwood has a school-wide behavior plan, called the Florida Positive Behavior Intervention and Support Program. PBIS uses proactive, reinforcement-based strategies to teach positive behaviors to students. PBIS establishes a positive school climate, increases safety and academic performance, and decreases behavior problems. Teachers and staff members give out "Hootie Bucks" to students who show good behavior and follow Carrollwood's expectations and rules. Students can use these "Hootie Bucks" to participate in monthly schoolwide reward events which include popcorn, games, movies, music and dancing.
