50 out of 87 HOSA members placed at the district Winter Leadership Conference to advance on to State Leadership Conference

23 out of 50 HOSA members placed at State Leadership Conference in Orlando to advance on to International Leadership Conference.

International Leadership Conference: Over 12,000 competitors were in attendance from 54 different countries and US territories. Of the 23 Williams students who traveled to Dallas to compete in International Leadership Conference, 9 placed in the top 10; 9 placed in 3rd; 1 placed in 2nd; and 2 placed in 1st
