COVID Protocols

The mask mandate has been extended for 30 days.

The mask mandate is now in place until October 15, 2021. The board allows for a medical exemption opt-out of the mask mandate.

The district will continue following other mitigation strategies on campus that are recommended by the CDC including hand sanitizer in all buildings and encouraging hand washing throughout the day. The district will also work with our health partners to provide opportunities for vaccination clinics.

The Board and the District will continue to monitor the situation along with our local health partners.

Bloomingdale Senior High School

1. Breakfast Procedures

a. Students entering from the bus ramp or student parking may purchase breakfast from the outside patio or inside the cafeteria.

b. Students entering from drop off area may purchase lunch from hallway station, cafeteria, or outside patio.

- c. Seating for breakfast is located in cafeteria or outside patio to allow for social distancing.
- d. The gym will also be open for students, who are not eating, to allow for social distancing.

2. Lunch Procedures

- a. Students will enter the cafeteria and sit at a lunch table, inside the café or the outside patio.
- b. Students will be dismissed to lunch lines, to allow for social distancing in the lines.
- c. Students may purchase lunch from inside lines or outside patio line.
- d. Students may eat inside or outside patio, to allow for social distancing.
- e. Students are to remain seated during lunch.

f. Students will be released from the cafeteria 2 minutes early to reduce student traffic during transitions.

3. Sanitation

a. Every classroom is equipped with sanitation supplies, including disinfecting wipes and hand sanitizer.

- b. High contact touch points (restrooms, door handles, etc.) are sanitized throughout the day.
- c. Wall hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the school.
- d. Water fill stations are located throughout the school.
- 4. Other
- a. Hallways are labeled to encourage one way traveling patterns during transitions.
- b. Social distancing is encouraged, when possible.
- c. Seating charts are required and updated as needed.
