## MILITARY & FEDERALLY CONNECTED PARENTS, YOU CAN HELP MAKE A DIFFERENCE FOR OUR SCHOOLS!

### What is the Federal Impact Aid Survey?

Impact Aid is a Federal education program that reimburses school districts for lost revenue and additional costs associated with the presence of nontaxable Federal property.

### Who should turn in Impact Aid Surveys to the school?

Eligible groups are listed below. Students with parents who:

- are active duty in the U.S. Military or a foreign military,
- work as a civilian employed on federal property including VA Hospitals, MacDill Air Force Base or other military installations, hotels/casinos on Indian-owned property, federal buildings, courthouses, cemeteries, parks, Army Corps of Engineers projects or other federally-owned property in Florida.

A partial list of eligible federal properties is included on the survey form.

### How are Impact Aid Funds used?

Impact Aid funds directly impact your child's education by providing funding to replace the loss of property tax revenue that can be used for everyday expenses such as materials, equipment, teachers, special education programming, and building improvements, as part of the general budget of the district.

### What can you do to help Hillsborough County Public Schools receive Impact Aid?

The Impact Aid survey form will be sent home to families on **October 12, 2021**. First, review the survey carefully to decide if your work or living situation applies to the survey. Then, complete, sign, and return to your child's school the next school day. All information provided is used to support our request for federal funds under the Impact Aid Program.

### Why is your survey important?

The amount of funds the school district receives is based on the number of Impact Aid Surveys returned.

### ¿Qué es la Encuesta de Ayuda de Impacto Federal?

La ayuda de impacto es un programa de educación federal que compensa a los distritos escolares por impuestos no recaudados y costos adicionales asociados con las propiedades federales.

### ¿Quiénes deben llenar y entregar a la escuela las Encuestas de Ayuda de Impacto?

Los grupos elegibles se enumeran a continuación. Estudiantes con padres o madres que:

- están en servicio activo en las Fuerzas Armadas de los Estados Unidos o en un ejército extranjero.
- trabajan como empleados civiles en una propiedad federal, incluyendo hospitales de veteranos, la Base de la Fuerza Aérea MacDill u otras instalaciones militares, hoteles/casinos que se encuentran dentro de propiedades de los indios americanos, edificios federales, tribunales, cementerios, parques, proyectos del Cuerpo de Ingenieros del Ejército u otra propiedad federal en Florida.

Una lista parcial de propiedades federales elegibles está incluida en el formulario de la encuesta.

### ¿En qué se utilizan los Fondos de Ayuda de Impacto?

Los fondos de Ayuda de Impacto influyen directamente en la educación de sus hijos al proporcionar fondos para compensar los impuestos sobre la propiedad no recaudados, los cuales se pueden usar para gastos diarios como materiales, equipos, maestros, programas de educación especial y mejoras en el edificio, como parte del presupuesto general distrital.

### ¿Qué puede usted hacer a favor de las Escuelas Públicas del Condado de Hillsborough para que puedan recibir la Ayuda de Impacto?

El formulario de la encuesta de Ayuda de Impacto se enviará a las casas de las familias el 12 de octubre de 2021.
