Dear Parents,

All teachers in Florida are supervised to ensure that they meet the certification and training requirements, as required by law. According to Florida Statute 1012.42, when a teacher is assigned a teaching position outside of his or her area in which he or she has been certified, the parents of all students in that class will be notified in writing.

Hillsborough County Public Schools is committed to providing quality instruction for all students, and it does so by employing the most qualified individuals to teach and support every student in the classroom. The district is assisting our teachers with the development of an individual Professional Development Plan to complete the requirements necessary for them to be certified in that area.

All of our teachers are certified to teach, although some of them are currently teaching outside of their area of certification, and are earning certifications in other areas. You have the right to know the professional credentials of the teachers or teaching assistants who are teaching your child. Federal law allows you to request information about your child's teachers and at the same time, requires us to provide it to you in a timely manner, if you request it. 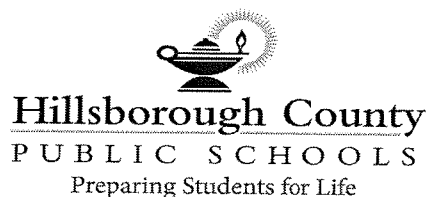
The graph below shows teachers who are currently teaching outside of their certification area.
