Starting the 2023-2024 school year, incoming 9th-grade Hillsborough County students will be able to attend the Medical Academy at D.W. Waters.

D.W. Waters will be undergoing an exciting transition and renovation, and will:

- Be structured similarly to a traditional high school
 - Career-focused clubs
 - General education courses and specialized workforce-related electives
- Have a smaller student enrollment
 - High-tech labs, innovative classrooms, and large equipment
- Provide students with:
 - Free workforce training
 - Mentorship opportunities with industry professionals
 - Career exploration opportunities

Transportation will also be provided for students who are accepted into the academy.

Students interested in participating in athletics can do so with their zoned neighborhood school.

- Allied Health (Radiology)
- Cardiology
- Emergency Responding
