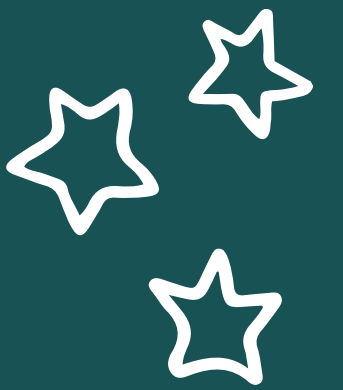

College/Trade School Students

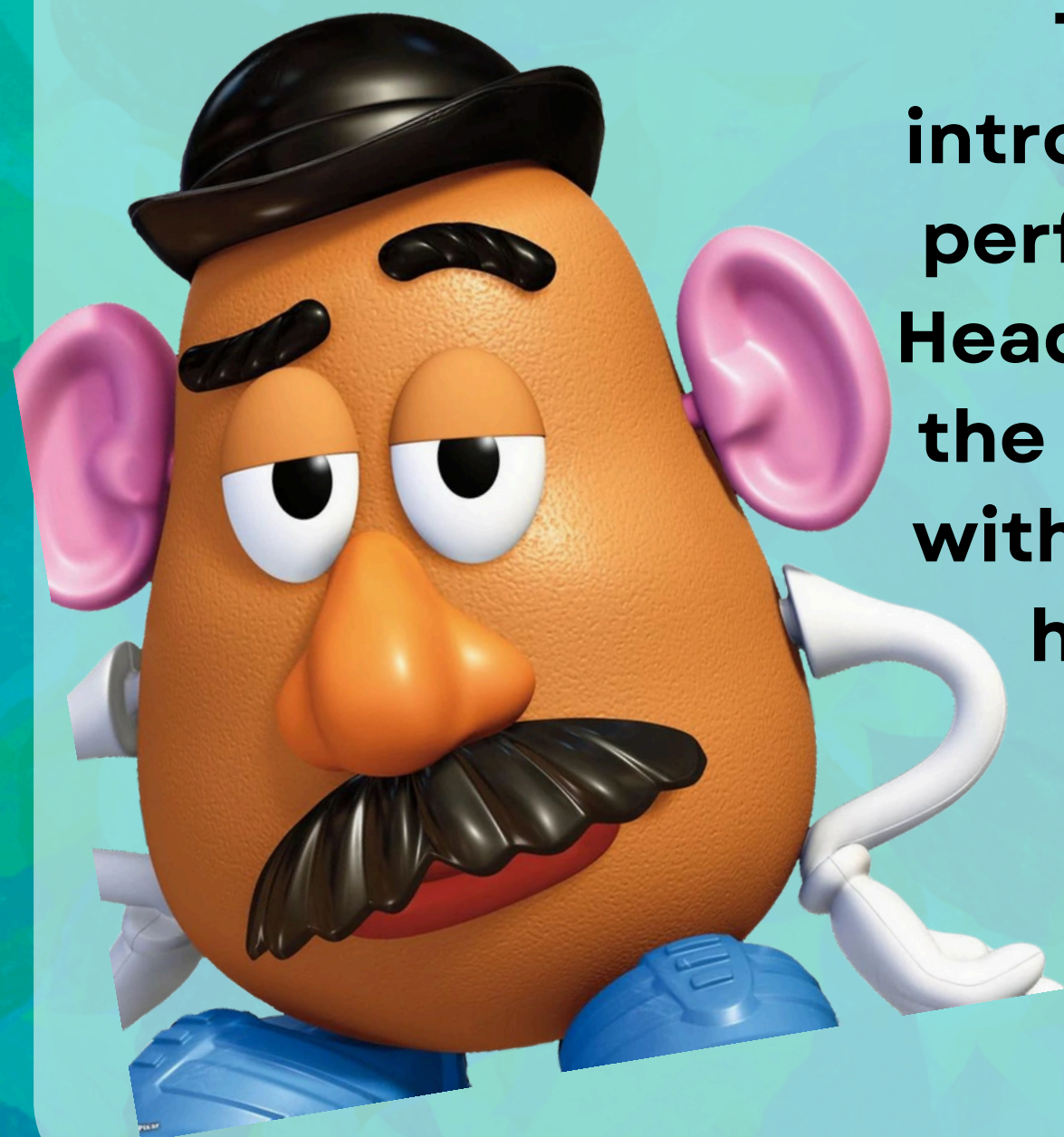

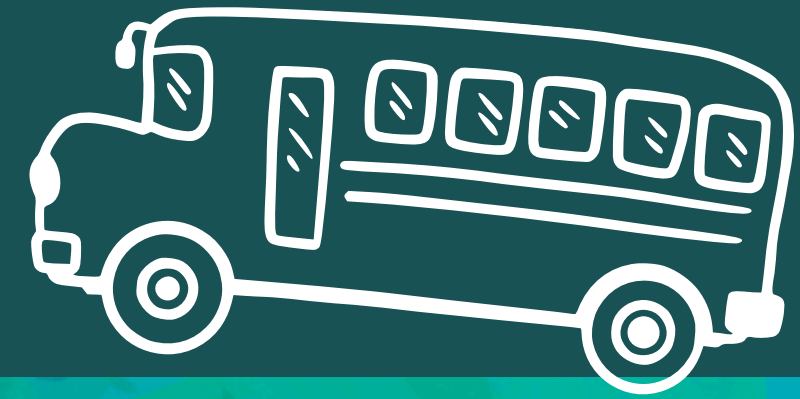
☆ ATTENDANCE AWARDS ☆

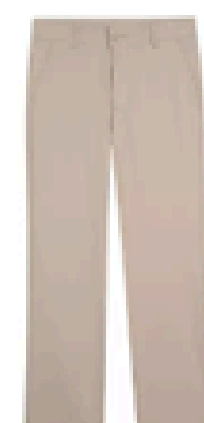
