Alafia Academic Awards Criteria for the 2023-2024 School Year Second Nine Weeks

Principal's Honor Roll: 1st-5th grade; All A's or E's; No Behavior Indicators

Honor Roll: 1st-5th grade; All A's and B's or E's and S's; No more than one Behavior Indicator

Citizenship: Kindergarten -5th Grade – No Behavior Indicators

Attendance Award: Kindergarten – 5th Grade - No Absences; No more than 3 days tardy; no more than 3 early sign outs.

For the 2nd nine weeks grading period we added an additional award students can earn; "The Alafia Impressive Improvement Award." This award can be earned by a student, by maintaining his or her grades from the 1st 9 weeks report card and demonstrating progress by an increase of at least one academic grade and/or by decreasing at least one behavior indicator, if any. Award certificates will be given to students by their teachers in their classrooms the week of January 22nd.
