Dear Parents,

October 8th marked the end of the first grading period and student report cards will go out electronically on Monday, November 1st. The school district will send out directions to all families on how to view your child's report card online. If you have any questions about the report card please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.

Each grading period we recognize our students for progress made as indicated on their report cards. Students will be recognized using the guidelines below. Children who meet any of the criteria below will be given a certificate congratulating them for a job well done, along with a certificate for a treat from a local venue. The first nine weeks awards criteria is for first through fifth grades only as we give time for our kindergartners to get acclimated to school. Kindergartners will be included in our awards beginning the second grading period.

Guidelines for awards for the 2021-2022 school year's First Grading Period are as follows:

Principal's Honor Roll: 1st-5th grade; All E's or all A's; performing On Level; No Behavior Indicators

Honor Roll: 1st-5th grade; All E's and S's or All A's and B's; Performing On Level; No more than one Behavior Indicator

Citizenship: 1st -5th Grade – No Behavior Indicators

Attendance Award: 1st – 5th Grade - No Absences; No more than 3 days tardy; no more than 3 early sign outs.

On another note, as you know, our Assistant Principal, Mrs. McGinnis had her last day with us on Friday, 10/22. The school district will announce at the November 16 school board meeting who our next Assistant Principal will be. We will all be anxiously waiting for that announcement, and we can't wait to welcome our new AP, whoever that may be!

As a reminder, for safety, students and adults alike are asked to not ride bikes on the sidewalks on our school campus. Once anyone enters the school campus on a bike or scooter, they must walk the bike/scooter. Also, please remember, no dogs, with the exception of Service Dogs, are permitted on campus at any time.
