Happy Holidays from 3rd Grade!

December will be keeping us busy in 3rd grade!!

In ELA we are reading both fiction and nonfiction texts and learning skills like how to connect illustrations and pictures to text and how to determine the point of view of the characters in a text. We're also practicing reading strategies across all texts like making predictions, using vocabulary strategies to figure out unknown words, and making connections to our lives. During independent times, students are working hard on iReady, Imagine Learning, and Achieve3000. In Writing, we will be continuing to focus on narrative writing, where we will continue to practice using specific details and transition words in our writing.

In Math students are working on being able to add and subtract within 1000. They will also be beginning a unit in geometry where they will learn how to describe and categorize shapes based on their attributes. Students will also be making connections back to their prior learning about area as they learn about perimeter.

In Science students are learning about the physical properties of matter. They are learning how to describe objects using vocabulary such as size, shape, texture, and hardness. Next, students will be working on their STEM Fair projects where they are coming up with a question they want to investigate.
