# <u>Free Tools to Improve Reading, Math, and Critical Thinking</u> <u>Achieve 3000</u>

One of the most effective ways to strengthen reading, improve overall literacy, and prepare students for the demands of college and career is to meet them one-on-one at their individual reading levels, while at the same time targeting grade-level state standards. Our school district is making this happen by offering ALL students in 3<sup>rd</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> grade access to Achieve 3000. To achieve the best results, it is recommended that students receive 4 activities or more in a month. Success is measured by students successfully reading articles article and scoring a 75% or higher on the **first try**. Students can access this program at home. Please encourage your child to complete lessons at home as well. This will improve their reading Lexile level and move them towards being college and career ready. At Lomax we are designating at least 2 days a week for our students to focus on Achieve.

# i-Ready



We are still encouraging the use of i-Ready for all students in K-5. Teachers are meeting with students in small groups and assigning lessons to address instructional needs of students based on the winter diagnostic and response to instruction. The expectation of i-Ready usage is for students to complete 45 minutes weekly in reading and math. The district recommended pass rate is 70%. We are encouraging our students to obtain a pass rate

of at least 75% or higher on their i-Ready lessons.
