

2023-2024 School Year Instructional program for Pre-K children!

Eligible children must turn four years old by September 1, 2023 and may not have previously participated in a Kindergarten or VPK program.

The VPK Program is the first 3.5 hours of the school day.

Each school will assign VPK seats based on a points system. Schools will notify

families that are awarded a seat in the VPK program no later than early April, 2023.

5 points will be awarded if the parent/guardian is a staff member at the VPK Site.

4 points will be awarded if the child is zoned for the Peeps/VPK school.

2 points will be awarded if the parent/guardian is an employee of Hillsborough County Public Schools.

<u>1 point</u> will be awarded for each criterion below:

- Parent or guardian is an active member of the military. (military ID must be shown)
- If a sibling is attending the VPK site for which the student is applying. (A "sibling" is defined as a brother, sister, half-brother, half-sister, stepbrother or stepsister, living in the same household.)
- Qualify for McKinney Vento Act

A WEEKLY fee for Extended Learning Time (after VPK) will apply.

(Full Pay=\$100, Reduced = \$50, Free= \$25)
