Year Round Closed Campus Policy

August 10, 2021

Dear Leopard Families,

In a continued effort to ensure the safety of our students and staff, the following procedures will be effective beginning **Tuesday**, **August 10**, **2021**:

- <u>Lutz K-8 will be a closed campus.</u> No parents/families will be allowed inside the school building to walk students to class. Staff members will be on duty around the campus to assist students. Students will walk to class independently, or with the assistance of staff members as needed.
- Tardy students arriving after 7:40am must be escorted to the office by a parent to sign in. These students will be walked to class by staff members.
- Any visitor (classroom performance, school ceremony or event, etc.) or scheduled volunteer (through your child's teacher or for PTA activities) must bring identification to the office to sign in. <u>No visitor/volunteer will be permitted access without identification.</u> No exceptions will be made.
- All volunteers should complete a volunteer application. This will be available on the district
 website in late July or early August. The volunteer application is located under the parent
 icon on the district website. Once there click volunteering in HCPS.
- <u>Visitors/volunteers must enter through the office to sign in and must exit through the office to sign out.</u> This process will ensure we know who is on campus at all times in the event of an emergency.
- The above volunteer policies are subject to change based on district guidelines.
- For student safety, early sign-out for students will end at 12:40 P.M. on Mondays and 1:40 P.M. Tuesday through Friday.
