Dear Student,

Thank you for your interest in Martinez Middle School's Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS.) Attached to this letter you will find information about NJHS selection criteria, membership obligations, and application materials: one Application Form and *two* Teacher Recommendation forms.

Please discuss your interest in NJHS with your **parents**. The individual service hours NJHS Members must complete often require a commitment of time from parents as well as Members; therefore, a parent signature is required on the application form.

#### Selection Criteria -

**Membership in NJHS is not automatic upon application.** Your NJHS application, Martinez Teacher recommendations, transcript, and other school records will be reviewed and rated by the Martinez NJHS Faculty Council. The rating scale will take into account all five pillars of NJHS – Character, Scholarship, Leadership, Service, and Citizenship. Be sure your Application materials offer an accurate reflection of your accomplishments in each of these areas. All information will be held strictly confidential and you will receive a letter with the application status.

- 0 In order to be considered for NJHS Membership, all Application materials must be submitted to Mrs. Leonard in Room 307 by Tuesday, January 18<sup>th</sup>, by 4:20pm. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS!</u>
- O Late applications will not be considered, so be sure to allow plenty of time to complete the process. Specifically, provide your Recommendation Forms to Martinez Teachers about 4–5 school days before the deadline. The Teachers will send me their forms directly, but please follow up with them.
- O The Martinez NJHS Faculty Council will review all Application materials and make recommendations for Membership. You will receive your application status in Homeroom by Friday, January 21st.
- If you are selected for Membership, you will be invited to attend a New Member Orientation on Monday, January 24<sup>th</sup> at 3:30pm as well as our Spring Induction Ceremony on Monday, January 31<sup>st</sup> at 6:00pm. PLEASE SAVE THESE DATES in your calendar and secure transportation to these events.

### National Junior Honor Society Membership Obligations



Membership in NJHS is an honor; in fact, to prove worthy of the honor, Members of this national society must meet **all** of the following obligations:

- 1. Character Members of NJHS strive to develop the following character traits: responsibility, respect, patience, courage, caring, integrity, self-control, cooperation, and perseverance.
- 2. Scholarship As an Honor Society, we have high expectations for academic performance. NJHS members must maintain a 3.5 GPA and A's in conduct each quarter.
- **3.** Leadership Members of NJHS act as student leaders, providing a positive role model to other Martinez students.
- **4.** Service A Service Hours Log documenting time spent volunteering must be maintained by all NJHS members and submitted each quarter for verification.
  - a. **Chapter Service Projects** All members participate and promote the NJHS Group Service Projects. We will have various Committees for you to select how to serve.
  - b. Individual Service Projects All members can independently complete additional service hours on their own. While Members are encouraged to serve on as many group projects as possible, this individual service may be completed through a church group, a scout group, a community volunteer effort, and/or opportunities offered at Martinez.
- 5. Citizenship All members comply with school rules. Office referrals, detentions, or suspension for behavior issues are not acceptable for members of NJHS.

#### Further Obligations:

I. **Fees** – Martinez's NJHS members pay Annual Chapter Dues and purchase a club tshirt. The total cost is \$10. The dues help fund Chapter activities. The tshirt identifies and promotes our club.

2. **Meeting Attendance** - Members are expected to attend all scheduled Membership meetings. Members who cannot attend a scheduled meeting must provide a written excuse to Mrs. Leonard.

#### When Membership obligations are not met:

Students who have been unable to fulfill obligations of our NJHS' Chapter are notified in writing that they are on "Probationary Status." Those on Probation will have one academic quarter to demonstrate their ability and willingness to fulfill all obligations of Membership in order to be considered a Member in "Good Standing." If they are unable to maintain Membership obligations, the Martinez NJHS Faculty Council will hold a hearing to consider the student's dismissal from the Chapter.

#### Resignation of Chapter Membership

Personal situations may change, and NJHS Members could find themselves unable to fulfill the obligations of NJHS membership. In this situation, Members have the option of tendering a Letter of Resignation instead of facing a disciplinary hearing and/or dismissal from the Martinez Chapter. Members are urged to meet with Mrs. Leonard if they feel their situation may warrant resignation from NJHS. Adviser will work with probationary Members to find ways to remain Members in good standing.
