First Day of School – Tuesday, August 10th

School day begins at 9:25 am and dismisses at 4:20 pm (3:20 pm on Mondays)

Students may be dropped off in car line beginning at 9:05am, unless you are enrolled in our before-school program (HOST). Car line begins off Pearson Rd off Durant Rd. Please remain patient and in your car at all times. Do not drop your children off until you pull all the way forward and come to a complete stop. **Visitors will not be allowed on campus for the 1st day of school. All campuses will be closed to visitors for at least the first 30 days.** Extra staff will be assisting with helping students find their way to class.

Bus Riders

Students who qualify for bus transportation are encouraged to ride the first day of school. Mulrennan staff will receive your child from the bus assist them in finding their way.

On the 1st day of school, expect that buses may run a bit behind schedule. This is due in part to new students who are unfamiliar with riding the bus, slight adjustments in the routes, and the lack of drivers. Some buses will be doing "double-runs" in the case of a bus driver being out. At the end of the day, please be patient. The bus drivers will be taking a little extra time dropping students off at their assigned stops.

Walkers/Bike Riders

Students who choose to walk or ride their bikes to school will follow all directions at crosswalks. Crossing guards are at certain intersections, and students may ONLY cross at those designated areas. For any parents who choose to ride their bikes or walk to campus with their students, please end your journey at the bike rack. Students will walk from that area on their own to the front of the school where Mulrennan staff will receive your child.
