Book Clubs – read, listen, speak, think

There are two opportunities for all students to join a book club. — Bulldog Book Club and the Dewey Diner Book Club.

The Bulldog Book Club meets every Thursday after school in the library. It ends around 5:30.

Students choose the book they read and determine how much they will read each week. We use the round table method so that everyone shares their thought, opinions, questions about the book, about their connections with the story, and about the comments of the others in the club.

Our current book is The Red Umbrella by Christina Diaz Gonzalez. We will have the book finished by the Christmas break. Then, we'll be selecting our next title. The Dewey Diner Book Club meets once a month during all lunches in the library. Students choose their own book to read from a specific section of the Dewey Decimal nonfiction collection. This month we all read a book from the 200s. In November we will be reading books from the 300s.

Students receive a Dewey button when they sign up and check out. I'll send out a reminder to all period 4 teachers the day of the meeting.

The next Dewey Diner meets on Monday, November 7.
