In partnership with NCAA Team Works[™], the Tampa Bay Sports Commission, the University of South Florida, myON[®] by Renaissance[®] and Hillsborough County Public Schools, elementary students (PK-5th Grade) will have the opportunity to participate in the Read to the Final Four[®] Literacy Program. The program is a unique reading challenge designed to engage elementary students of all ages and fuel their excitement for reading by incentivizing them along the way. The reading competition will begin in January 2025 and feature four quarters of play. Each grade will participate in a two-week challenge and will compete based on the average number of minutes read. Read to the Final Four will culminate in a three-week March Madness® challenge especially designed for third graders.
