- School colors are green, black, grey and white

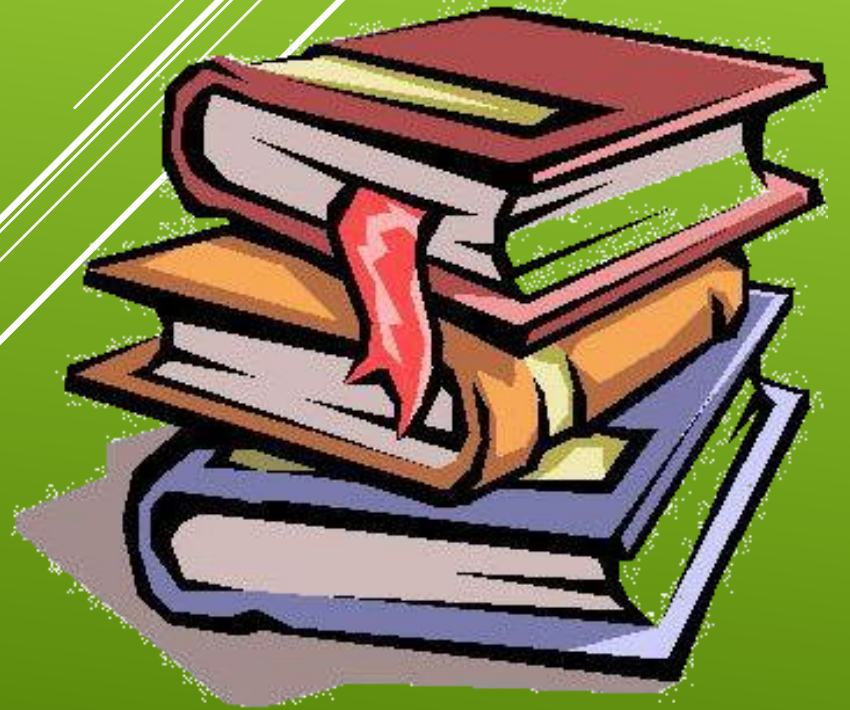
School Hours

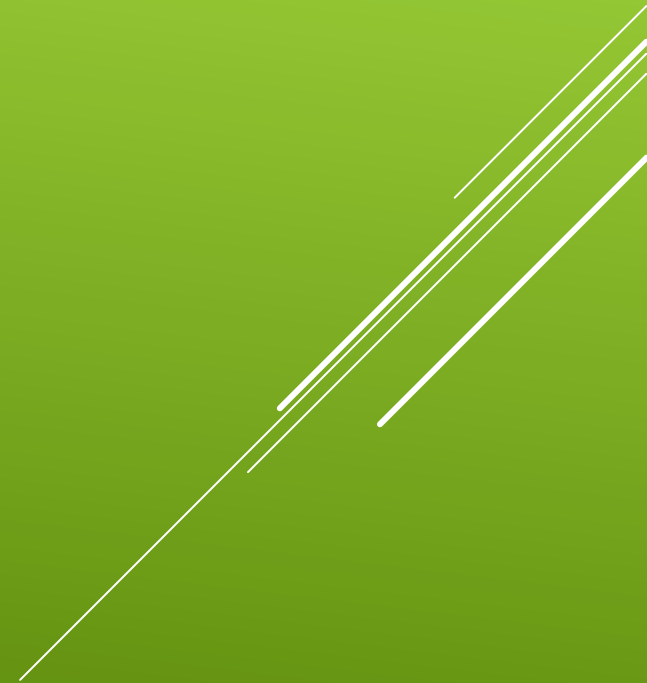

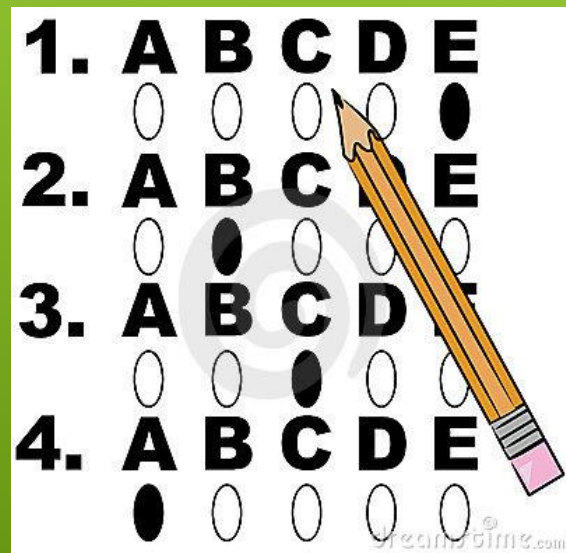

Curriculum and Scheduling Information

Academic Levels for 6th grade students are determined by FSA scores. Students without previous test scores will automatically be placed in advanced classes. Call AP requesting a change.



Regular(4) - Course title will read course name.

Advanced(5) – Course title will read Advanced.

Honors(0) – Course title will read Advanced Honors.

Gifted(G) is the same academic level as Honors.

Identified in Math and Science in 6th grade and Math in 7th grade. Course title will read Gifted.

Promotion Policy

Sixth grade students must pass language arts, mathematics, science and social studies to be promoted to seventh grade.

Grading Scale

| F = 0 - 59 | 0 point value |

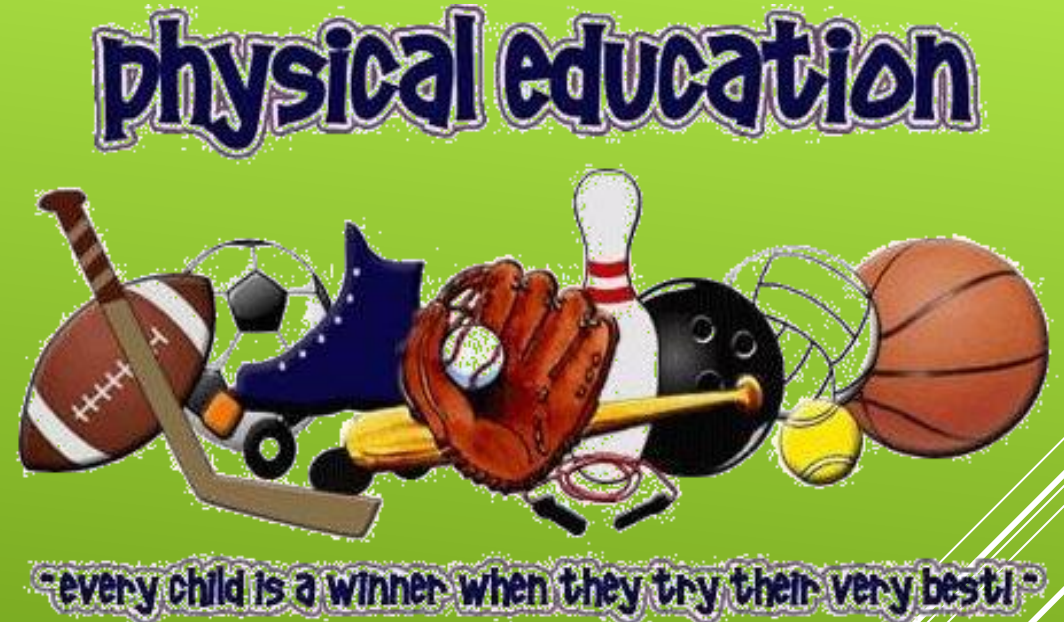


To pass an annual course, students must earn at least two quality points per semester. Students with at least two quality points will be assigned a final semester grade based on the average of two, nine-week grades. Students who do not earn the minimum quality points must make up the corresponding semester of the course.

- Will not dress out.



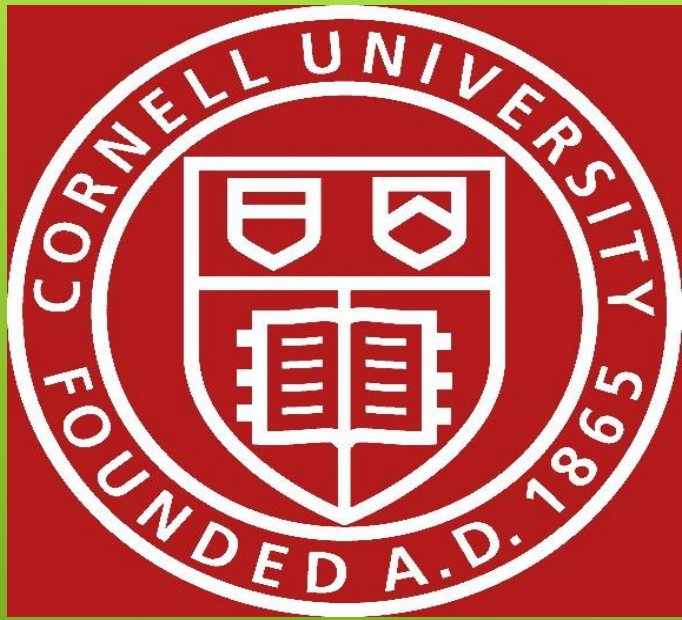
Sports Program
