In your response you are going to describe how the democratic governments in Athens and Rome influenced the United States government system.

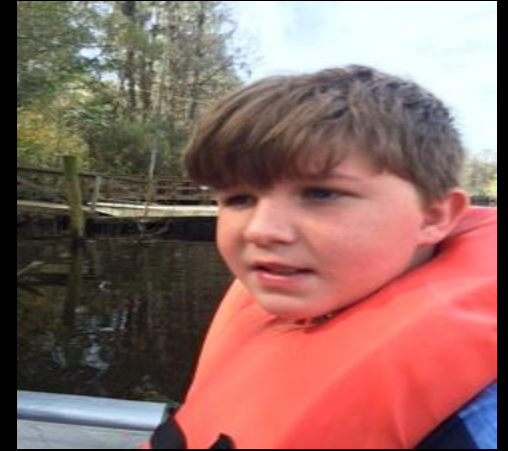

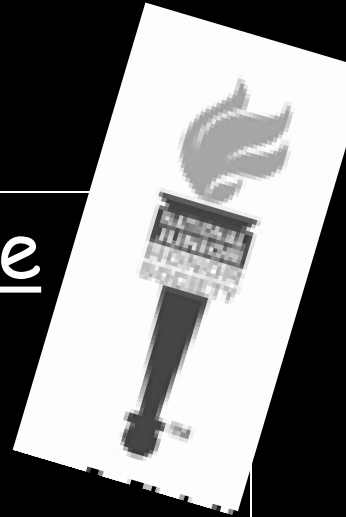
