

AICE Exam Results FAQs

1. My score says ungraded, what does that mean?

An ungraded mark on an AICE exam is not a passing mark. Only scores of a-e are passing. UNGRADED indicates a standard below the required score needed for Grade E(e). It is important to remember that the grades are on Cambridge's grading scale, not an American grading scale. The score of "e" can be looked at as equivalent to the "AP" grade of 3. It is passing to count towards the AICE diploma and would grant college credit.

2. What do these other scores mean?

- X or “No Result” means one of the following:
 - We were notified that the student was absent or withdrawn from one or more components of the syllabus
 - We were not notified that the candidate was absent or withdrawn and there is no record of a mark in one or more components of a syllabus
- “PENDING” or Q: means a result cannot be issued at present but will follow in due course.

3. Is it necessary to take a retake for all failed exams?

In a normal scenario, no, it is not necessary. There are two main reasons students sign up for retake exams:

- they are working on the AICE diploma and are working to acquire 7 passed exam points in three years.
- they are interested in earning the college credit for the course and feel strongly they would be successful at a second attempt.

Ultimately, the student has benefited from the internationally rich curriculum and the weighted GPA points, so re-taking an exam is not always necessary or helpful.

3. Does my student need to re-take the class?

No, the Cambridge exam is separate from grade earned in the course each semester.

Exam Retake Information- June 2024

On August 13th, Cambridge released the exam results for the June 2024 series exams.

Once candidates have received their results, they are able to re-take an exam that they received an “UNGRADED” score. If your student received a score of a “U,” meaning ungraded, he/she is eligible to purchase a retake examination. UNGRADED indicates a standard below the required score needed for Grade E(e). If a student wishes to retake an AS exam, he/she must take all components for that AS.

Students who have received a “U” on their examination still earn high school credit for the AICE course taken as long as they passed with a “D” or higher in the course.

If you are interested in retaking an exam, please see the schedule below to view what retakes are offered and the dates of the retakes. **The deadline to submit a retake request is Friday, September 6th and you are responsible for paying the \$121.15 fee for each exam you retake.** Payments will be submitted through My Payments Plus.
