LAST MINUTE SENIOR REMINDERS
CLASS OF 2023

-Yearbooks: Yearbooks are sold out. If you ordered a yearbook, they will arrive mid-May. We will distribute them to you once they arrive. I.B. Students, we will arrange to get the yearbooks to you.

-Baby Pictures: We will be showing a slideshow at graduation. We want to show each of you as baby and then your senior year picture. Please go to the school website, complete the baby picture form and submit ONE baby picture.

-I.B. Seniors Last Day: The last day for I.B. Seniors will be Wednesday, April 26, 2023. You will have a celebration in the Cafeteria during 4th Block. You will be “Clapped Out” at the end of the day.

-Traditional Seniors Last Day: The last day for Traditional Seniors will be Thursday, May 18, 2023. You will come to school at 9:00am and report to the cafeteria. We will provide you breakfast. We will have Senior Awards. We will show a slideshow. You will be “Clapped Out” at 11:45am, and then you will be done for the day.

-Senior Awards Night: Senior Awards will be in the morning on May 18, 2023 – the Traditional Seniors Last Day.

-Coming Back on Campus: After our last day of instruction, if you come back on campus during the school day for any reason, you must sign in at the Main Office.

-AP Testing: AP Testing will be held in the Gymnasium the first two weeks of May. You should know the date and time of your exam. Please arrive when instructed to take the exam. If you take an AP Exam, you will not attend any of your classes on the exam day. You will come to school, take your AP Exam, and leave campus. If you do not take your A.P. exam, you will be charged a fee.

-Senior Exams: If you are required to take your semester exams, you will take them on Friday, May 19, 2023, in the Media Center. You will be notified if you must take a semester exam prior to this date. If you must come to test, you are only permitted to be in the Media Center and must leave campus once you have completed your exams.

-Pay all DEBTS: You are NOT permitted to participate in the Graduation Ceremony if you owe any money to the school district. Please clear all debts by Friday, May 12, 2023.

-Graduation Rehearsal: Graduation Rehearsal is on Thursday, May 18, 2023 at 6:00pm at the Expo Hall - State Fairgrounds. Graduation Rehearsal is required to have an outstanding ceremony. Please be there by 5:30pm. Check the weather before you leave for rehearsal. Dress comfortably for rehearsal. No parking fee for rehearsal. Be careful driving on the Fairgrounds.

GRADUATION INFORMATION:

-Graduation: Graduation will be at 3:30pm on Sunday, May 28, 2023 at the Expo Hall – Florida State Fairgrounds. Please be there by 2:30pm. Every car WILL have to pay for parking (\$8.00). Cash or card only, no app and no coins.

-Dress: You MUST dress appropriately for Graduation. Ladies – Dresses or skirts which do not exceed the length of your gown. Men- Dress Pants, Dress Shirts, Ties, and Dress Shoes. NO Tennis Shoes, NO Jeans, NO Flip Flops.

-Arrival: You must wear or carry your cap & gown through security and then put it on BEFORE you enter the Expo Hall. You will need a school issued ticket for entry if you are not wearing or carrying your cap and gown.

-Caps and Gowns: Gowns and caps may NOT be accessorized except for school issued/approved cords, stoles & medallions. If you are not dressed appropriately, you will not participate in the ceremony.

-Throwing of Caps: Caps will NOT be thrown at the end of the ceremony.

-Don't Bring: Do not bring any of the following: gum/candy, noisemakers, food, flowers, beach balls, balloons, **cell phones (leave them with family).**

-Diplomas: Diplomas will be distributed immediately after the ceremony. Graduates will meet family members at their cars after they pickup their diploma.

-Graduation Tickets: Friends and Family are not permitted into the Expo Hall until 30 minutes prior to the ceremony. Every graduate will receive ten (10) tickets. These tickets will be distributed to the graduates at Graduation Rehearsal. The graduation ceremony is also broadcasted on the internet at <https://www.hillsboroughschools.tv/>

***Graduation is a FORMAL CEREMONY!!! You have worked 13 years to get here. Your parents have worked 18 years to get you here. You must be on your best behavior and act accordingly or you may jeopardize participating in the graduation ceremony and/or getting your diploma after the ceremony.
