

# LET'S TALK ABOUT MORE OPTIONS

---

## **VIRTUAL**

Students can choose to take up to three virtual classes at a time through HVK12 or flvs.net

This is completed online at home.

## **OJT**

This is an elective course for juniors and seniors who need to leave 1 - 2 periods early to go to work.

Students must already have a job.

## **DUAL ENROLLMENT**

Up to ten college credits per semester are available to eligible high school students. Ask your school counselor for more information.

## **CREDIT RECOVERY**

This takes the place of an elective. Students will be in credit recovery if they failed a class.
