What is Axis 360?

Axis 360 works like a traditional library...but online. The school district has several copies of e-books and audiobooks available for students and staff to check out online. Just like in the standard library, if all the copies of the book are checked out, you'll have to wait for someone to return a copy. Because the selection of books is similar to a traditional library, Axis 360 offers books that aren't available on **myON**. Please note: To place holds, you will need an e-mail address. You may check out up to 3 books at a time, for 2 weeks.

Using a Desktop Computer

FIND AXIS 360: Go directly to Rodgers' Axis360 catalog by

- Going to Rodgers website (mysdhc.org/Rodgers) > Under Resources click Media Center > Click the Axis 360 icon **OR**

LOGIN: Your Library ID is 7 digit student number(students) OR L+employee number (staff).

Find a book and tap on its cover. You can choose *Checkout* if the book is available, Place Hold if it is checked out, or (with the drop-down arrow) Add to Wish List to save for later.

Hint: if the icon on the top left of the book is light gray, no copies are currently available.

- Once you've checked out your book, click on the Read Now button. Any books you check out from the website will be available on your mobile app, too. Make sure your pop-up blocker is turned off so you can read the book!
- If you want to stop reading, log out. When you are ready to continue, log in and go to Welcome at the top of the page to find your book.
- Your book automatically returns at the end of the loan period, but if you go to the Welcome area, you can return it earlier. (Choose the book, then More Options.) Find your Wish List in this area, too.

How do I use Axis 360 on a Mobile Device?

- Download the Axis 360 app (available for almost all mobile phones and tablets). Go to your app store and search "Axis 360".
- Search for our school, which is HCPS Rodgers Middle.
