ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

ARRIVAL (7:10-7:35am)

- Supervision begins at 7:10am. Please do not drop off your child before 7:10am.
- Our morning show begins at 7:30am. If dropped off after 7:30am, your child may/may not make it to class on time and may be marked tardy.
- The tardy bell rings at 7:40am.

EARLY SIGN OUTS must occur prior to 12:15/1:15 respectively. Please be prepared with photo ID and school issued car/dismissal tag for smoother dismissal process.

DISMISSAL (Monday 12:55-1:10pm and Tuesday through Friday 1:55-2:10pm)

Dismissal is 12:55/Mondays and 1:55/Tuesday through Fridays.

HOW WILL MY CHILD GET TO/FROM SCHOOL?

BUS RIDERS

- Transportation has provided the following information so you know your child's bus information. www.hillsboroughschools.org then search *Here Comes the Bus*.
- PLEASE begin bus services the very first day of school to ensure child, bus driver, and staff are familiar with the routines. Changes after day one lead to confusion.

CAR RIDERS

- If you drive to school for the arrival/dismissal process, your child must be a car rider.
- Your child should be able to get in/out of the car independently.
- Adults must remain in their vehicles at all times.
- Please note: one lane (right) for loading/unloading; the left lane is for passing.
- Please wait until you are given the signal before beginning the passing process.
- All campus exits are for right hand turns only during the arrival/dismissal process.

WALKERS Students who are walkers must be able to walk home independently.

OTHER INFORMATION

CIRCLE DRIVE AT FRONT OF SCHOOL During the arrival/dismissal process, the drive by the main office is reserved for buses, day care vans, VPK. Please refrain from parking in reserved parking.

VPK & KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS Per district policy, all VPK/K students must be met by a parent/guardian at bus stops or at the walker exit. In situations where students are car or day care riders, students must be met by an adult as well.

NEIGHBORHOOD PARKING Please be a good neighbor and model for your child: following rules and being a good citizen. We are not allowed to use the church parking lot, streets in the neighborhoods (ex. Webb Rd., Tanglewood, Civic Rd.), or business parking lots for our arrival/dismissal process. If you drive to school, your child should be a car rider.
