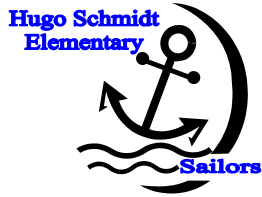

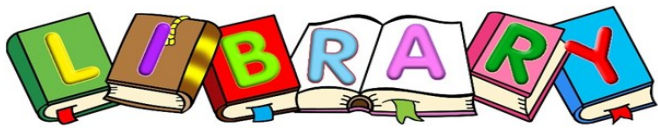

Please visit the Center to register. All programs are free of charge.

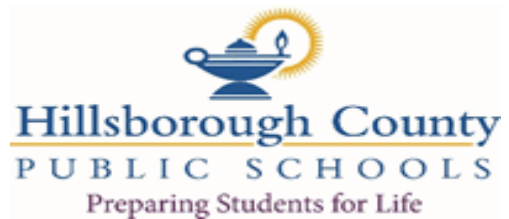
