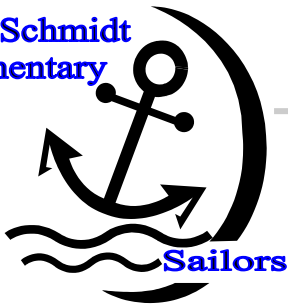

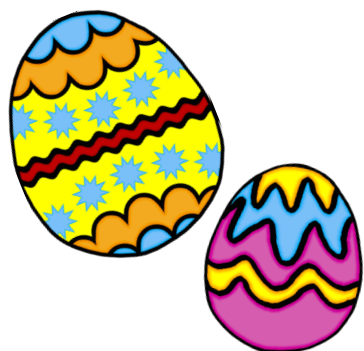

## PACK A SACK

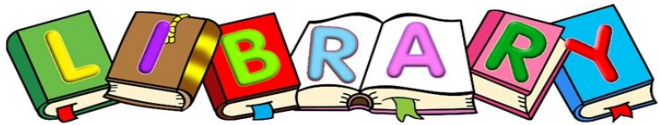
This bag of food came from Pack a Sack, a ministry of Limona Village Chapel.
