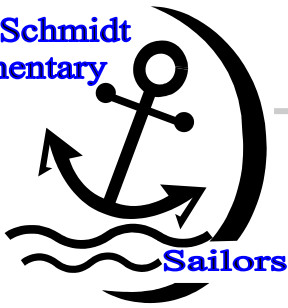

#### Dear Parents,

We are off to a great start. It's hard to believe that we are near the end of the first quarter on October 8th. Our teachers have been busy assessing students so that they can plan appropriate instruction for them. As part of their daily schedule, teachers have begun Response to Intervention (RTI) at each grade level. They focus on acceleration for struggling students and enrichment for others. Teachers are working with children from the time they arrive in the room to the final dismissal bell. This is why **punctuality is vital to student success**. When a child is tardy, that child missed opportunities to learn and grow.

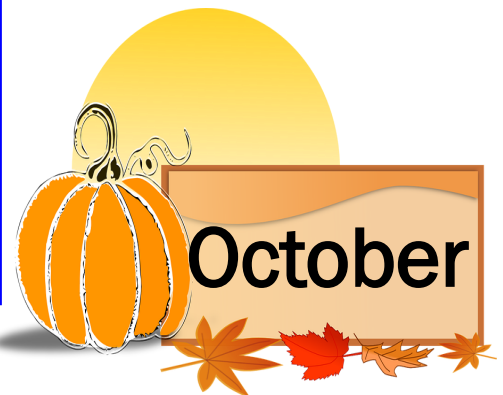
**Arrival and Dismissal**- Please remember that the bell rings at 7:40am sharp and your student should be **in their seat** prior to 7:40. If students are late, we ask that parents complete a form at the front office and ring the bell. We want as few interruptions in the classroom as possible. A bag breakfast will be offered in the office from 7:35-7:45. **After 7:45, breakfast will not be available at school.** Please remember that outside food (McDonalds, Dunkin Donuts, WAWA, etc.) will not be allowed in the classroom. Also, any parent arriving after 1:30 will be asked to wait until dismissal at 1:55. Please plan accordingly if you have an appointment after school.

**Conference Night**-This year we will have 2 conference nights. Our first one will be held virtually during the week of November 1-4<sup>th</sup>. Teachers will send home information closer to the week to schedule a time. Communication with parents is key to student academic success.

We will again post our **monthly** newsletter on the website for you to view and refer to during the month. I also record a **Sunday night call** using the Parentlink system to update you on weekly happenings. To receive my call, we must have an accurate and active phone number on file. In the event your phone number changes, please contact the school as soon as possible so we can update our records.
