Tops: Solid color, collared polo or t-shirts – black, gold, white, purple or navy or a Seminole Spirit Shirt.

Bottoms: Shorts, skirts, jumpers, or pants, in navy, black or khaki. A belt must be worn if pants are loose. Jeans can be worn on Fridays only WITH a uniform top or a Seminole Spirit Shirt.

Shoes: Must be closed toe and sandals must have a strap on the back.
