<p>Hillsborough County Schedule Change Policy</p> <p>Valid reasons for a schedule change may include: counselor or computer error, failing a required course, passing a course in summer or night school, lacking a grad requirement, and lacking proper prerequisite.</p> <p>»Unofficial schedules will be mailed home approximately 2 weeks prior to the beginning of school. There will be opportunities for <u>necessary</u> schedule corrections at that time.</p> <p>»Elective changes generally cannot be honored due to teacher unit allocation.</p> <p>»Schedule change requests will not be considered for the purpose of teacher preference.</p> <p>»A change request may require the entire schedule to be altered, including teachers and periods.</p> <p>»Once a schedule has been changed, it cannot be changed back to the original schedule.</p> <p>»Failure to complete summer reading does not constitute a valid reason for a schedule change.</p>	<p>Bright Futures Service Information:</p> <p>*Review Community Service procedures and download forms from our website. Students will complete both the "Proposal" and "Hours Log" and will submit both forms to guidance after the hours are complete to be logged into the system. Check your status online as well.</p> <p>*As long as service hours meet guidelines and signatures are obtained, the forms will be accepted. Students can volunteer during summer for hours to count towards BF's and will turn in forms starting September.</p> <p>FLVS Information:</p> <p>*Course requests for FLVS courses must be completed online at www.flvs.net by the student. Do not list FLVS courses on this sheet.</p> <p>* Counselors <u>periodically</u> review FLVS requests that are submitted over summer.
