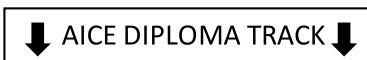

Foreign Language	Not required for high school graduation, but at least 2 credits in the same language are required for admission into 4- year universities

Online/Virtual	At least <u>one course</u> within the 24 credits required must be completed through online learning.
GPA Requirement	2.00 G.P.A. (unweighted)
