Paperwork deadlines for Summer and Fall terms have already passed.
Deadlines for Spring term will be announced on Canvas.

- Step 1 - First time Dual Enrollment students must complete the online application at <https://www.hccfl.edu/admissions/dual-enrollment-and-early-admissions>
- Step 2 - Test Scores! If you have already taken SAT/ACT/PERT you can submit the subscore from your test to HCC. If you need to take the PERT you can contact the HCC Advising Office via email for further instructions.

HCC now offers remote PERT exams! To sign-up for a PERT exam, please contact your campus Advising Office via email below, and they will provide instructions to get you started. Please email from your Hawkmail account and include your HCC student ID number.

To complete a remote PERT exam, you will need the following:

- A laptop or desktop with webcam and Internet access
 - Your Student ID number and Hawkmail address for login purposes
 - A **current** photo ID available for identification and verification purposes at the time of testing.
 - A quiet, distraction-free testing location
- Step 3 - Meet with a dual enrollment advisor at HCC to discuss the courses recommended based on your test scores.
 - Step 4 – After meeting with an HCC advisor, reach out to your East Bay Counselor for Authorization Form B.
 - Form B will be filled in by you and must include the courses that you want to take.
 - Once you have filled in the form your counselor will sign it and return to you electronically along with your most recent student summary.
 - Step 5 - Email Authorization form B and your student summary along with any testing reports to dualenrollment@hccfl.edu
 - Step 6 - Keep an eye on your email for approval from HCC Dual Enrollment with next steps on how to register for the courses and order any needed textbooks.
 - Step 7 - Once you are registered for classes send your HCC Schedule to your East Bay School Counselor.

Dual enrollment students must have a 3.0 unweighted GPA, meet test score requirements, and provide their own transportation if leaving campus for courses.
