ATTENDANCE CALLS

Parents, when your child is sick or will not be in school, please call the attendance line first thing in the morning to report the absence, so that your child will be marked as "excused". Call 740-4000 and press "1" to report your child's absence. If the attendance mailbox is full, press "0" to speak with someone in the office. Please remember, if you let your child's teacher know that your child will be absent, you must also call the attendance line. Please know you will still receive an automated call and/ or email from the county.

NO PARKING IN OSPREY PARK OR SKATE PARK

Please avoid parking your cars in the Osprey Park neighborhood at all times. Both parents and students residing in that subdivision have expressed concerns with excessive cars parking on both sides of the street, pulling in and out, and causing safety hazards. We want all of our Broncos to arrive at school and back home in a safe, orderly manner. If your child is not going to walk or ride their bike home, we ask that you follow the procedures we have in place to pick up students via cars. In addition, please do not park at the skate park. This situation creates a visual and safety hazard that could result in an injury to one of our children. Please use extreme caution when entering car drop off/pick up areas. Thank you!
