If an **emergency** requires a change after the school day begins, please call the school office before 1:30pm, rather than leaving a message on the voice mail. This will ensure that the teacher receives the information prior to the end of the day.

STUDENT SIGN OUT

For the safety of your child, any student who must leave prior to dismissal will be released through the front office only after being signed out by an adult whose name appears on the emergency card. PLEASE KEEP YOUR CHILD'S EMERGENCY CARD UP-TO-DATE.

Additionally, the morning of the sign-out, please send a note to your child's teacher to let them know you will be signing your child out. This helps ensure that backpacks and lunch boxes will be with the student they are signed out during recess or lunch.

The LAST TIME to sign your child out on Mondays is 12:15 and Tuesday-Friday is 1:15 due to the transitions necessary for a safe dismissal. Thank you!
