


GUIDANCE CORNER

DISTRICT ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY: CELL PHONES AND WATCHES () C

Personal devices can **only** be used in approved areas under direct supervision of school personnel. Electronic devices, including watches, must be turned off or muted and should be kept in backpacks during school hours. Using functions on electronic devices in any manner that disrupts the educational environment is not allowed. Audio or image recording whether through picture or video, without prior consent of the individuals being recorded is prohibited. Students bring personal devices to school at their own risk.
