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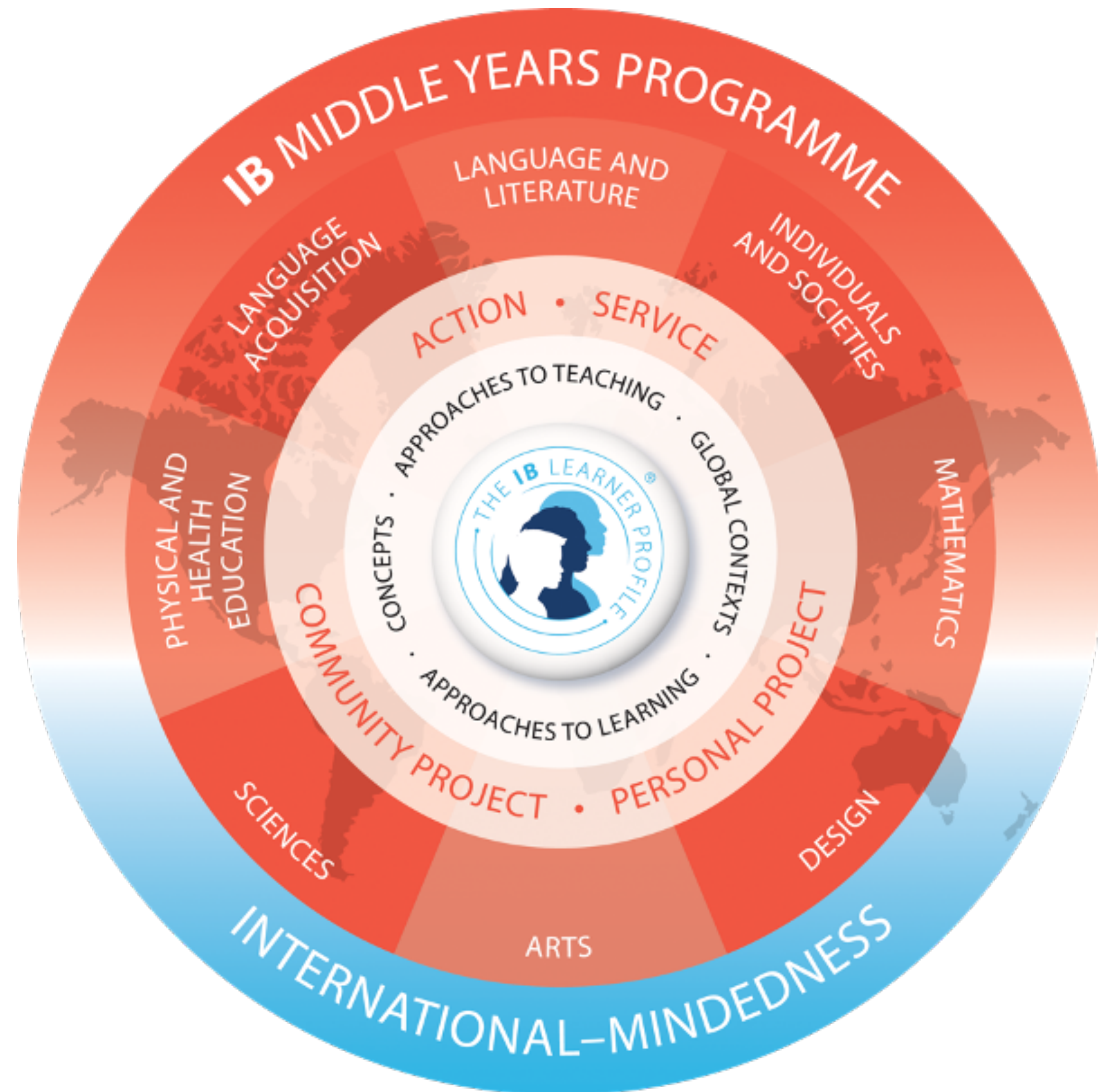

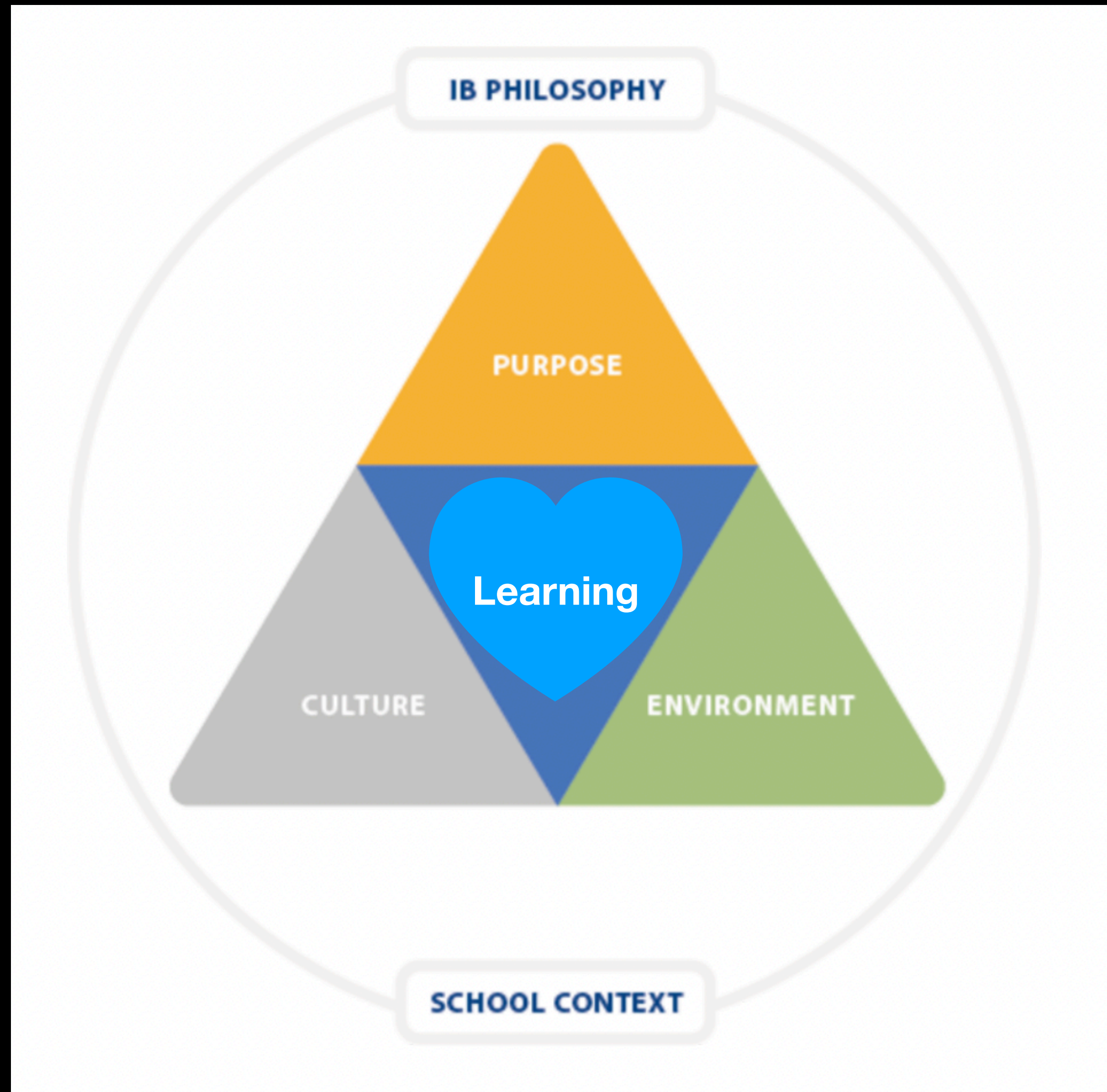

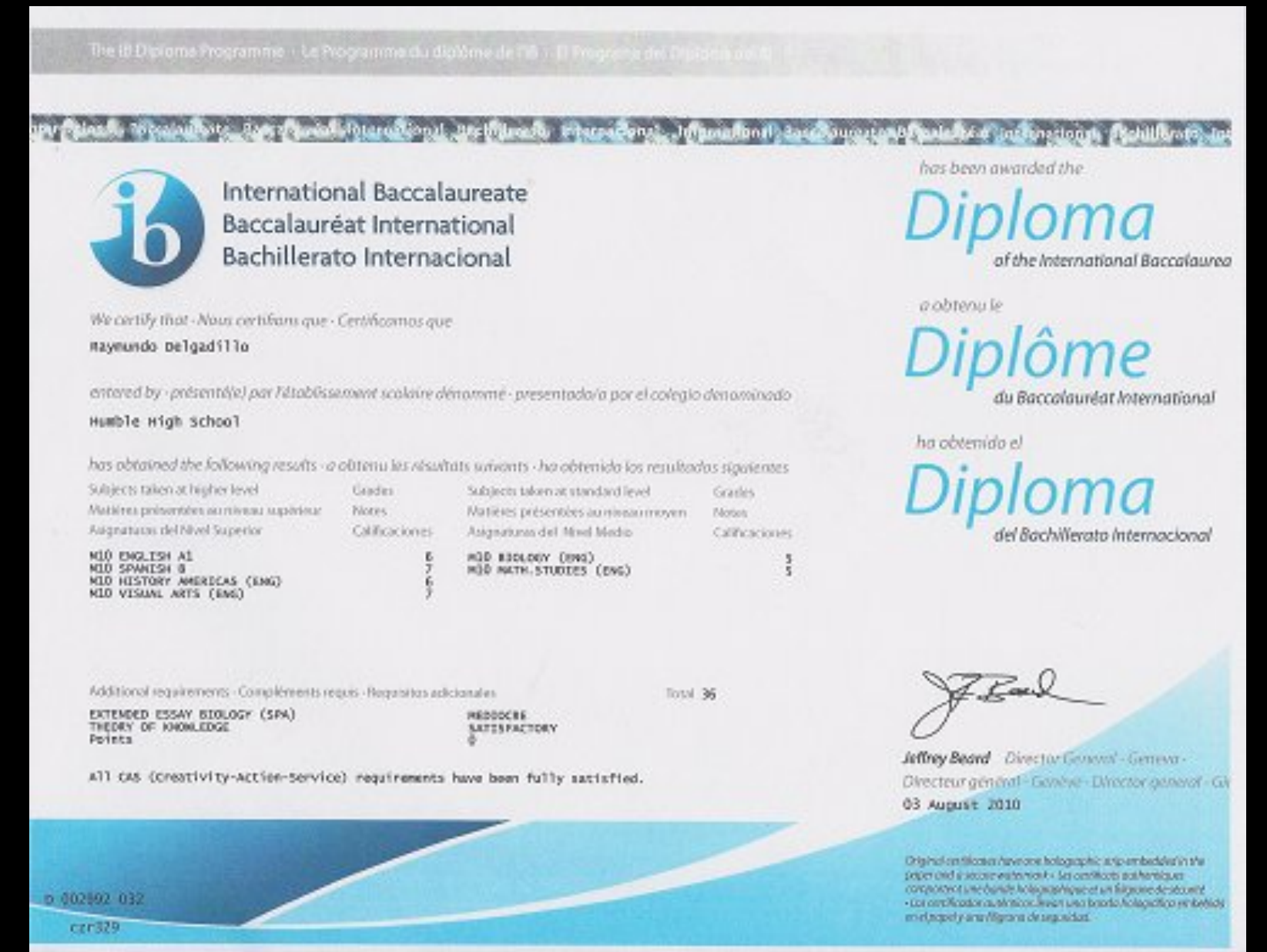

# IB MYP is for ALL Students



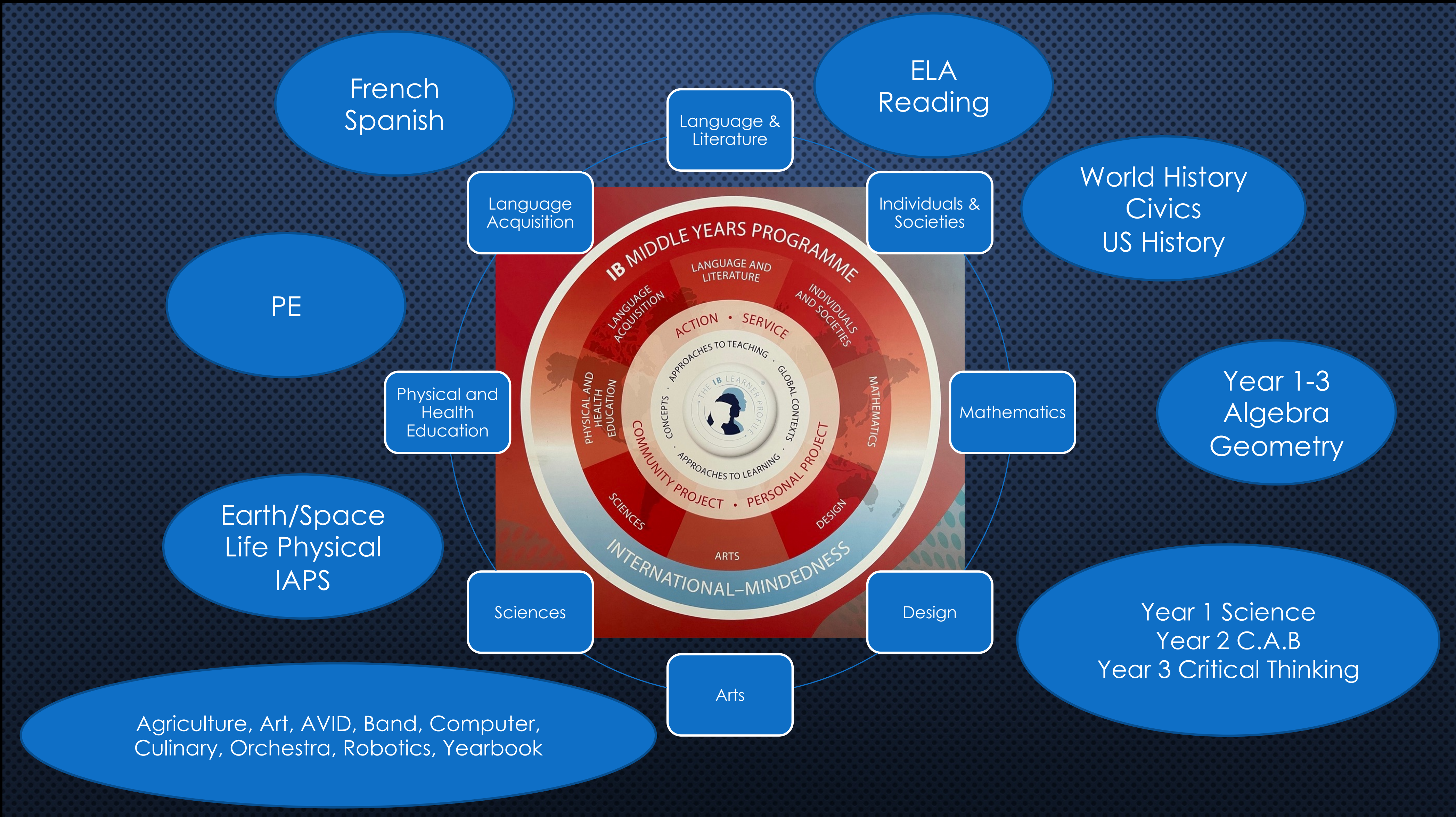
- There is NO academic requirement to enter Walker Middle Magnet.

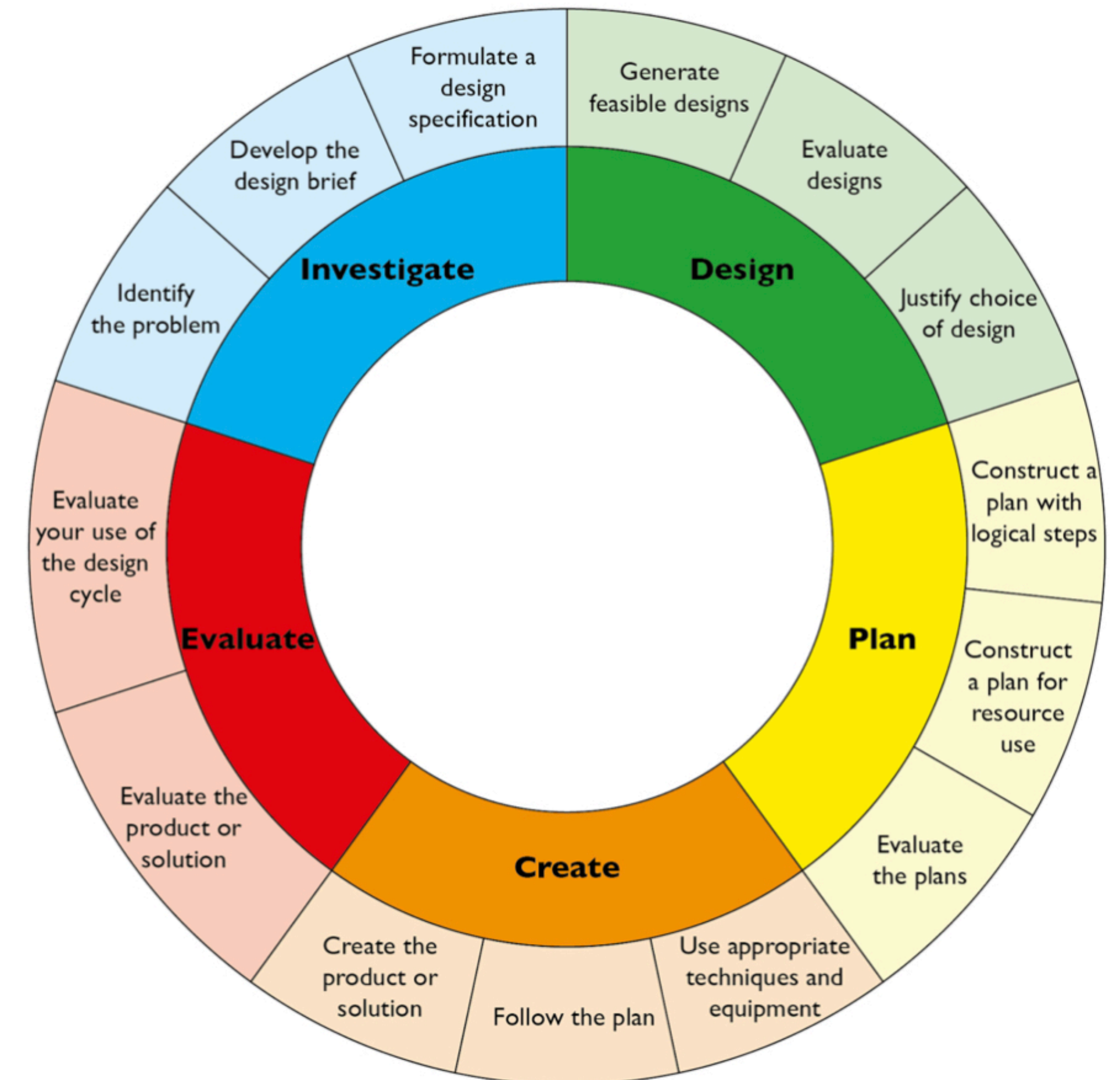


# Design

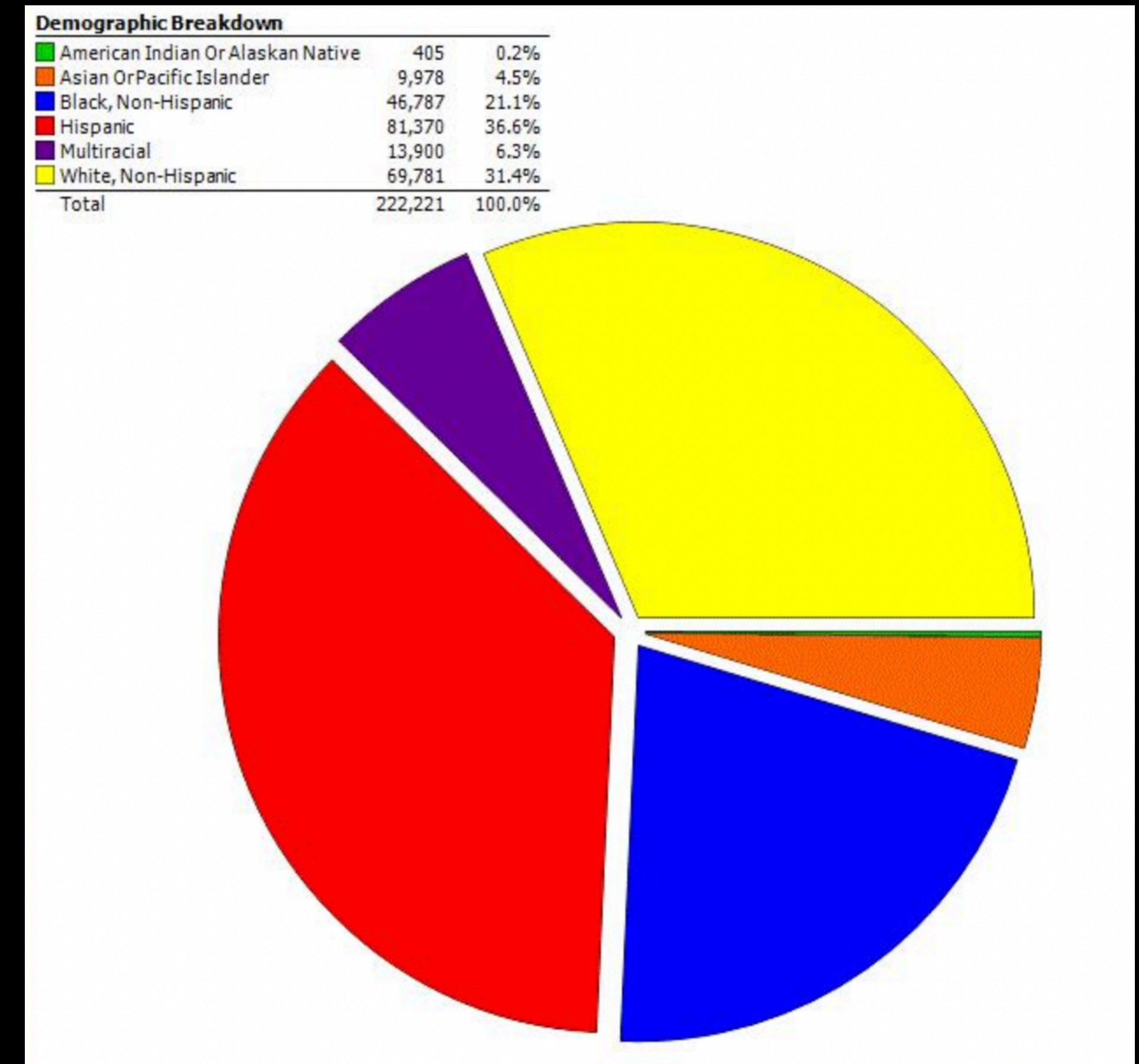
