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






Logging in to Canvas Parent Accounts



Webb Middle School Electronic Device Campus Protocol.

New Legislative HB 379 states, students may not have cell phones, air pods or any other WCD (Wireless Communications Device) out during class instructional time, including P.E. classes unless requested by the teacher for instructional purposes. All students will be asked to place cell phones and/or WCD in a provided storage area OR the device must be in the bookbag at all times. Teachers will provide cell phones/WCD procedures in their syllabus as parent notification of the policy.

STUDENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO TAKE THEIR WCD WITH THEM WHEN LEAVING THE CLASSROOM DURING INSTRUCTIONAL TIME.

1ST AND 2ND OFFENSE

• Teacher warning and parent/guardian contact.

3RD OFFENSE

• Device is held until end of school day and returned to student. Parent/guardian contact.

4TH OFFENSE

• Student must turn in phone for 1 week at start of day and returned to student at end of school day. Parent/guardian contact.

5th OFFENSE

• Student's phone privileges will be removed for a time assigned by administration. Parent/guardian contact.
