HOW TO JOIN



Westchase is a Non-Uniform School

Dress Code:

- Shoes shall be worn and securely fastened to the feet. Footwear must be suitable for the outdoors (recess). "Skate tennis shoes" are NOT allowed.
- <u>Tube tops, spaghetti straps,</u> or similar type clothing, shall NOT be worn.
- Torso and/or midriffs, either front, back, or sides, shall NOT be worn.

- Head coverings such as <u>hats shall NOT be worn in the building</u> unless required for religious observance or health-related reasons.








- FREE Summer program to ensure kindergarten readiness (dates and times to be determined)
