BASIC SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

6th Grade:

6th Grade teachers will begin the year helping students to organize their work by period. 6th grade students will use a three-ring binder with divider tabs for each class. Students will assemble binders during the first week of school and are expected to have all supplies ready by the 2nd week of school.

- One 1.5" Clear View Binder with clear front and back cover pockets
- Seven dividers (buy an 8-pack and you will have one extra)
- One Pencil Pouch with three holes to fit in the binder
- Pencils
- Wide Ruled Notebook Paper
- School Planner (available at school) or personal planner

7th / 8th Grade:

- One 1.5" Clear View Binder with clear front and back cover pockets
- Seven dividers (buy an 8-pack and you will have one extra)
- One Pencil Pouch with three holes to fit in the binder
- Pencils
- Wide Ruled Notebook Paper
- School Planner (available at school) or personal planner
- TI-30Xa scientific calculator

***Keep these supplies in stock all year: glue sticks, colored pencils, pencils, pens, wide-ruled notebook paper, highlighters (multi-color), hand-held pencil sharpener with cover, and scissors.

Teachers will provide additional lists as needed for their classes.

Monday-Thursday:

Friday:
