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
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





The <u>Student Literacy</u> and Media (SLAM) Showcase is a district K-12 event celebrating reading!

All submissions are due on or before Thursday, January 23,2025!




How are students selected to represent Williams at the district SLAM Showcase on March 5th?

If they attend, you can even get your favorite author's book signed!




You will have the opportunity to meet some of the SLAM book authors! After the event, we'll eat lunch together before we return to school!





1 minute video








- (1-3 students per project)

- Maximum length for the video is one (1) minute.


Video Art: Slide 1 of 8


Category 2: 2D CREATIVE EXPRESSION STUDENT CATEGORY (1 student per project) 3D media can NOT be accepted, including relief.







2D Art: Slide 7 of 7



Create 3D Art or other **3D** Creative Expression for one of the 2023-2024 SSYRA (6-8) nominee books. **Only individual projects** are accepted.



Examples of 3D Creative Expression include, but are not limited to, Ceramics, Sculpture, Mixed Media, Fine Crafts (jewelry, stained glass, mosaic), Robotics, Diorama, Board Game, etc.



3D Creative **Expression works** must be stable and not exceed 4'X4'X4' and 30 lbs. Student must be able to transport, carry and set up their 3D work.

Category 3: 3D CREATIVE EXPRESSION STUDENT CATEGORY (1 student per project) • Entry must be appropriate for "PG" rated



audiences.

Entries must also follow all General Guideline Rules.

Category 3: 3D CREATIVE EXPRESSION STUDENT CATEGORY (1 student per project) Must include a Reader's Statement that communicates how the piece was inspired by one of the Florida award nominated books.






By entering the SLAM Showcase, entrants accept and agree to be bound by these Official Rules as well as the requirements for their specific division and category. Entries which do not meet the general and/or category specific guidelines are subject to disqualification.



ELIGIBILITY: Students must attend Hillsborough County Public Schools in grades K-12. Students must participate through their library media center.



DIVISIONS: Students may enter in the appropriate division, having created work(s) inspired by a book in the Grades 6-8 Division –2024-2025 SSYRA (6-8) nominee books.



CATEGORIES: Students may enter the SLAM Showcase multiple times and in more than one category. Students who submit multiple entries must have works inspired by different books from the 2024-2025 6th through 8th grade list.

Creativity: Each entry must be the original work of the student. An adult may not alter the creative integrity of a student's work. Because the program is designed to encourage and recognize each student's creativity and personal connection to the literature, help from an adult is not allowed, except for the Guidelines for Participation for Students with Disabilities.



Reader's Statement: Each entry must include a Reader's Statement. The **Reader's Statement** communicates how the piece was inspired by one of the Florida award nominated books. The **Reader's Statement must** include at least one sentence but may not exceed 300 words.



Copyright: Your SLAM Showcase entry must not use video, music, or images that you do not have the right to use. Entrants are responsible for copyright considerations. Entries without appropriate copyright permissions and/or plagiarized entries will be disqualified.



Division/Category Guidelines: Each entry must also follow all the appropriate Division and Category Guidelines.

Official Guidelines for Participation

GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES HOW TO ENTER: Students who identify as having a disability have two options for entering the SLAM Showcase. **Option 1: Enter in Grade-Level Division: Students may enter in their** grade level division using the reading list(s) applicable to their assigned grade level. Students are afforded access to accommodations, as needed, as identified in their IEP or 504 Plans. Students in the Grade-Level Divisions complete all required activities and are recognized as part of the general student population.







GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES **Option 2: Enter in Grade-Level Division as a Special Reader: Participation as a Special Reader offers** every student the opportunity to participate using books from the grade level reading lists most appropriate for them, in a manner that promotes inclusive practices.

GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES **Option 2: Eligible students entering as Special** Readers are not required to complete all activities as those required for the general student population. Special Readers create their own unique work product inspired by a book from the reading list most appropriate for them.





Option 2: These works may be in the form of a 2D Creative Expression or Video Creative Expression which allows the Special Reader to express an aspect of the book they have chosen.



GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Option 2: Students are afforded access to accommodations, as needed, and as identified in their IEP. **Students are recognized** as Special Reader participants in their **Grade-Level Divisions.**
