



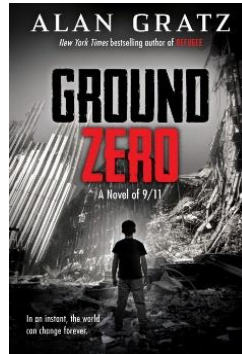
# WILSON MIDDLE SCHOOL Summer Reading List 2023-2024

Dear Parents and Students:

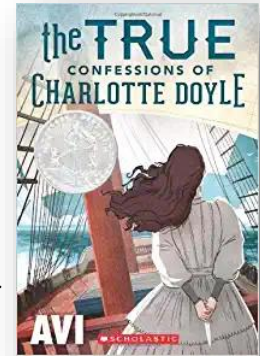
