Blake Homecoming Policies and Guidelines

The purpose of this document is to provide a safe and enjoyable atmosphere for all students attending this function - **PLEASE READ!**

Policies and consequences:

1. **There will be no refunds issued to either the BHS student or the guest for any reason.** ALL tickets must be purchased via Hometown Ticketing online. Tickets are \$40 per person (no refunds!) Please be reminded that once you have purchased your ticket, you **MUST** remain discipline-free (no OSS, no level 2 referrals) in order to attend the dance. Should you receive disciplinary consequences after the ticket is purchased, you will **NOT** be given a refund! The same rule applies to your guest.
2. **To be admitted into the event, PROOF of ticket purchase via physical ticket, Hometown tickets receipt, or ID must be displayed either on your phone and/or printed out and presented at the door. Guests must have an official photo ID (school or state issued).** Tickets will **NOT** be sold at the door! Students will **NOT** be allowed to re-enter the dance for any reason if they leave the lobby.
3. **All participants must follow the “code of conduct” as described by Hillsborough County Public Schools, as well as those found within the Blake High School Student Handbook (Student Code of Conduct / Overview (hillsboroughschools.org) and directives given by Blake Administration, Chaperoning Teachers, Law Enforcement and/or event security or management.** Any person not responding to the requests made by the aforementioned will be asked to leave and/or be escorted off the premises, with appropriate consequences to follow (no refunds).
4. **The dress code will be strictly enforced. Those not in compliance will not be admitted.**
 - a. This is a semi-formal event and the attendees should dress accordingly.
 - b. Dresses should be semi-formal. No low-cut dresses or dresses with large “cut-outs” will be allowed. Extremely “short” dresses will not be allowed. Modesty is always a good policy! If you have a question about the appropriateness of your dress, do not wear that dress!
 - c. Semi-formal also means the wearing of a tuxedo or a suit. (i.e. a suit jacket & dress pants, along with a dress shirt and tie/bowtie, belt, and shoes).
5. **Backpacks or large purses and bags will not be permitted and all bags will be searched.**
6. **External food/drinks are not be permitted** (light snacks will be served during the dance).
7. **This is a school function and all attendees and vehicles are subject to search.** Parking is free.
8. **Inappropriate behavior on the dance floor or in any other location within this venue relative to this event, will result in you and your guest being asked to leave the event (no refunds). Illegal behaviors will be dealt with by Police and/or Sheriff Department.**
9. **Any person found responsible for damages to the venue will be held legally liable for all costs and fees incurred from repairs and litigation.**

Tickets are limited. Tickets must be purchased via “Hometown Ticketing” from **09/01/22 through 09/30/22, 12:00 PM**—no exceptions. Tickets will **NOT** be sold on campus or at the door.
