



Storybook Pumpkin Project



HELP!!!! The pumpkins do not want to be carved this year, so they need you to disguise them as your favorite book character! Mrs. Service our Library Media Specialist, invites you and your family to use your creativity to help them hide from the carvers!

Guidelines:

1. Decorate and/or dress the pumpkin as a storybook character.
2. You may use ONLY plastic or fake pumpkins! Plastic or fake Gourds and squash may also be used!
3. Use EVERYDAY materials to bring your Storybook Pumpkin "to life". (examples: acrylic paint, cotton, yarn, markers, etc.)
4. Please do not carve pumpkins or poke any holes in your pumpkin. CARVED or REAL pumpkins will not be accepted.
5. Make sure that your pumpkin is small enough for the student to carry to school and large enough to be decorated!
6. Add a label showing the character's name, the title of the book, as well as the student's name, grade, and teacher.
7. Get Creative--USE YOUR IMAGINATION AND HAVE FUN!!!

Storybook Pumpkins are due no later than Thursday, October 17th.

Teachers will be given ballots for students to Vote for their favorite pumpkin! Pumpkins will be on display during our Fall Conference night on Thursday, October 24th in the Library Media Center.

ALL students who enter will receive a treat.

A free book from the Book Fair will be awarded to the winners in each grade level on October 24th.
