Please read the attached Summer Reading Requirements information carefully. THIS IS NOT AN OPTION! However, your child does have a choice in his/her reading selection. Reading more than one novel during the summer in middle school is ideal, but only one assignment will be collected/graded.</p>

Notes to Families:

- MYP Teachers worked collaboratively to comprise a supply list that is minimal. *Choose your own brands and styles!*
- We chose lighter items to be housed in backpacks to reduce the weight due to no lockers and NO ROLLING backpacks.
- Folders & Composition notebooks will be for the entire school year. Some teachers refresh quarterly, and some teachers change each semester. Teachers will collect the extras and house them in the classrooms. *Any colors will do.*
- Heavier items such as binders, multi-subject notebooks, Art Sketchbooks, and textbooks will remain in the classroom with links on Canvas to access at home. *(TIP: Trapper-Keeper-style binders are NO longer recommended as they add too much weight to the backpacks. Color-coding folders is a suggested idea). Any colors will do.*
- Post-it Notes and notebook paper will be shared among teachers and divided up during the first days of school.
- Pencil pouch supplies should be refreshed often. We recommend you keep backstock of those supplies at home to replenish as needed and to ensure backpacks are not weighted down.
- Items, such as glue sticks, pencils and Post-it Notes, are used often and in all classes, so please be sure your child has plenty all year long. *Donations of these items are always appreciated.*
- Teachers will create individual *Amazon Wish Lists* and send out links to their families. These items are to enrich the curriculum but are not on the required Supply Lists.
