Schedule Change Policy

Valid reasons for a schedule change may include: computer error, failing a required course, passing a course on virtual school or night school, lacking a graduation requirement, and lacking the proper prerequisite. Elective changes cannot be honored due to teacher unit allocation. Schedule change requests cannot be considered for the purpose of teacher preference. A change request may require the entire schedule to be altered to meet the request you have made, including different teachers and different class periods. Once a schedule has been changed, it cannot be changed back again to the original schedule. The student is responsible for all class work from the beginning of the semester, regardless of the date the student entered the class.

AP (Advanced Placement) Courses

Students and parents understand and agree that by signing up for an AP course:

- 1. I will be expected to complete summer assignments/ projects and failure to do so will not result in a schedule change.
- 2. The course(s) will be challenging, and I will be expected to produce work that is held to a higher academic standard.
- 3. If my grade is lower than I desire, it is incumbent upon me to work harder to raise it.
- 4. A schedule change will not be granted during a semester because of low grades.
- 5. I am expected to make realistic decisions when signing up for AP classes, and I will not be able to change out of a class after the semester begins.

<u>Virtual / Dual Enrollment Periods</u>

Students may request a virtual period off-campus when taking an online course and/or dual enrollment course provided that:

- Scheduling on-campus classes allows for off-campus periods.
- Students are signed up for the virtual and dual enrollment courses prior to the start of the semester.
- The number of virtual courses does not exceed three.
- The number of dual enrollment credit hours does not exceed ten.
- The total number of courses (on-campus, dual enrollment, and virtual) meets the minimum requirement of seven.
- The student remains enrolled in the course for the semester. Dropping a course requires that a new class be scheduled to meet the minimum requirement of seven.

Course Selection Info

Please understand that course selections are not guaranteed and are subject to change based on end of year performance data. Additionally, elective choices cannot be changed once these selections are submitted. There will be NO elective schedule changes during the 2021-2022 school year under any circumstance. Further, AP courses are a full year commitment and students will not be able to withdraw from an AP course.

I am aware of the programs offered to my child at Riverview High School, and I agree with his/her choices as indicated. I have also read and understand the schedule change policy. I understand that I will not be able to drop any chosen classes (including AP) or request schedule changes once the school year begins.
