Firefighter Academy



This program prepares students for entrylevel positions as firefighters. Students learn the knowledge and skills needed for the Florida Minimum Standards Firefighter exam.

Once completing the academy, graduates receive a career certificate and are qualified to take the state Firefighter II certification exams. The curriculum includes comprehensive training that prepares candidates to take the State exams and follows the framework set by the Florida Bureau of Fire Standards and Training.

Examples of topics covered: orientation to the fire service, fire alarms and communication, vehicles, apparatus and equipment, fire behavior, portable extinguishers, fire streams, fundamentals of extinguishment, ladders, hoses, tools and equipment, forcible entry, salvage, overhaul, ventilation, rescue, protective breathing equipment, safety, controlled burning.
