

ALTC Fire Fighter Program Admissions Checklist

Hillsborough County Fire Rescue and Tampa Fire Rescue

All potential students must attend the Orientation session. The date of the Orientation for the August 2021 fire academy will be posted on the website by April 15, 2021.

A lottery will be held following the Orientation session to award open seats. Students who are awarded a seat must set an appointment with our Guidance Counselor and complete the Registration process.

The following 12 items must be submitted at Registration:

1	Residency Form (See page 2 of form and provide 2 proofs documenting 1 year or more residency in FL)
2	_ Hold Harmless Form - Notarized (<u>original</u>)
3	Personal Inquiry Waiver Form - Notarized (<u>original</u>)
4	_ Training Affidavit - Notarized (<u>original</u>)
5	_ Tobacco Affidavit – Notarized (<u>original</u>)
6	Copy of Driver's License or State of Florida Photo ID
7	_ Florida EMT, Florida Medic, NREMT license, <u>or</u> a Diploma/Certificate dated within the last year from an approved EMT program
8	Original High School diploma, original GED, sealed High School transcript, or sealed advanced degree transcript from an approved, accredited US school
9	_ Medical Examination Form - <u>Must</u> be on the form given at Orientation
10	Application for FF Certification Exam – <u>Must</u> be on the form given at Orientation
11	State Fire Marshall Candidate Fingerprint Receipt (original) - Directions will be given at Orientation
12	Full payment for the program: \$2,122.00 for Tampa Fire (plus, students must rent their own bunker gear = approx. \$1,000) \$3,122.00 for Hillsborough County Fire (bunker gear rental is included in that price)

(You must to be prepared to pay in full for the program when you register. Or, if an agency (CareerSource WIOA, VA, VR, Florida Prepaid, Florida Bright Futures, etc.) will be paying, you must bring a letter, voucher, or other proof that they will pay. Until you have that documentation, you will not be allowed to register. If the agency pays part of the costs, you will have to pay the remaining costs at Registration. See the information under the "Financial Aid" link for details. Note: VA, Florida Prepaid, and Florida Bright Futures programs do NOT pay the full cost.)
