Admissions Checklist

* All potential students must attend the Orientation session on December 10, 2021 at 10:00am at Aparicio-Levy Technical College*

A lottery will be held following the Orientation to award open seats. Students who are offered admissions will receive a registration packet with all registration forms listed below AND must schedule an appointment with our ALTC Counselor to complete the registration process on the day of their appointment.

The following	12 items must	be submitted	at Registration	1:

1	Residency Form - See <u>Residency Guide</u> . For in-state tuition, provide 2 proofs documenting 1 year or more residency in FL.
2	Hold Harmless Form - Notarized (<u>original</u>)
3	Personal Inquiry Waiver Form - Notarized (<u>original</u>)
4	Training Affidavit - Notarized (<u>original</u>)
5	Tobacco Affidavit – Notarized (<u>original</u>)
6	Copy of Driver's License or State of Florida Photo ID
7	Florida EMT, Florida Medic, NREMT license, <u>or</u> a Diploma/Certificate dated within the last year from an approved EMT program
8	_Original High School diploma, original GED, sealed High School transcript, or sealed advanced degree transcript from an approved, accredited US school
9	Medical Examination Form - <u>Must</u> be on the form given at <u>Orientation</u>
10	Application for FF Certification Exam – <u>Must</u> be on the form given at Orientation
11	State Fire Marshall Candidate Fingerprint Receipt (original) - Directions will be given at Orientation
12	Full payment for the program: \$2,150.00 for Tampa Fire Academy (plus, students must rent their own bunker gear = approx. \$1,000) \$3,150.00 for Hillsborough County Fire Academy (bunker gear rental is included in that price)
	(You must to be prepared to pay in full for the program on the day of your registration appointment. Or, if an agency (CareerSource WIOA, VA, VR, Florida Prepaid, Florida Bright Futures, etc.) will be paying, you must bring a letter.

(You must to be prepared to pay in full for the program on the day of your registration appointment. Or, if an agency (CareerSource WIOA, VA, VR, Florida Prepaid, Florida Bright Futures, etc.) will be paying, you must bring a letter, voucher, or other <u>proof</u> that they will pay. If the agency pays part of the costs, you will have to pay the remaining <u>costs at Registration</u>. See the information under the "Financial Aid" and "Payment Information" links for details. Note: VA, Florida Prepaid, and Florida Bright Futures programs do <u>NOT</u> pay the full cost.)
