The Senior Awards Ceremony begins at 6:30 PM, and we invite all who want to support the Class of 2025 to attend. Seniors who are required to take exams will be notified this week, with exams scheduled for May 16th, 19th, and 20th. And don't forget—Senior Send Off takes place the morning of May 15th. Senior parents, please look out for an additional ParentLink with more details on these final celebrations and events.


